

CHIPPER USE POLICY

- Chipper will only be used during regular working hours
- Chipper will only be operated by approved Village employees
- Chipper will not be parked off of the public right-of-way
- All wood waste that the resident wishes the Village to chip up shall be
 - Placed at the curb with cut ending facing the street
 - Shall be no more than 6 feet long
 - Small branches shall be tied with string into bundles not to exceed 40 pounds
 - Shall be less than 8 inches in diameter
- Chipper will be used to clean up trees damaged due to a storm or routine yard wood waste, no yard waste, garden waste, flowers or entire trees that have been felled by a professional tree remover, will be picked up by Village employees.
- It is not the intention of the Village of Fredericktown to be in competition with private companies and to remove a complete tree that is located on private property.
- The Village will use the chipper for removal of any trees located in the Village's right-of-ways.
- The Village will not charge the residents for removal of any wood waste. However, the crew will only spend a maximum of 15 minutes at any one residence during each scheduled chipping route.
- The Village will not charge for removal of trees that are damaged due to severe wind or ice storms.
- **The Village will be chipping on the first and third Tuesday of each month, May thru October, weather permitting. Storm damage will be chipped as soon as possible.**
- Wood chips from the chipping service are available to anyone by making arrangements ahead of time. **Wood chips will be delivered, in full truckloads only, within one mile of the Village limits.**
