ORDINANCE 2022-11

AN ORDINANCE AWARDING THE HIGH STREET WATER TOWER REHAB PROJECT TO WORLDWIDE INDUSTRIES, INC., AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR VILLAGE ADMDINISTRATOR TO SIGN AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH WORLDWIDE INSUDTRIES, INC., AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Fredericktown has publicly solicited bids, according to federal and state law, for the High Street Water Tower Rehab Project, and received and publicly opened five (5) such bids; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Fredericktown's engineer, contracted exclusively for this project (Dixon Engineering), estimates this construction will cost approximately \$460,000; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Fredericktown believes that the bid of \$391,380, submitted by Worldwide Industries, Inc., what the engineer has determined to be the *lowest and best bid* and thereby recommends Village Council award the said project to Worldwide Industries, Inc., on the terms and conditions set forth in the bid received and set forth in the Village's bid specifications; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Fredericktown, Knox County, Ohio, as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** That the Village Council shall award the High Street Water Tower Rehab Project to Worldwide Industries, Inc., on the terms and conditions set forth in the bid received and set forth in the bid specifications, at a cost not to exceed \$391,380.
- **SECTION 2.** That Dixon Engineering, Inc., shall provide inspection services in the amount not to exceed \$24,500, in order to ensure that the rehab work is done strictly in compliance with the Village bid specifications and according to the Worldwide Industries, Inc., bid.
- **SECTION 3.** That the Mayor and/or Village Administrator are authorized to sign a contract with Worldwide Industries, Inc. pursuant to the Contractor's bid received and to the terms and conditions in the Village's bid specifications.
- **SECTION 4.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare and shall be effective immediately. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to fully complete this project while Fredericktown Local Schools are out of session for the summer.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency and shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
