RESOLUTION NO. 2022-21

A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE 2022 SEWER SEPARATION PROJECT PHASES 9, 10 & 11 TO UNDERGROUND UTILITIES, INC., FOR A COST OF \$577,411, AND PASSING AS AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Sewer Separation Project is mandated by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and deemed necessary for the health, safety and well-being of the community; and

WHEREAS, storm water currently infiltrates the Village of Fredericktown's sanitary sewer system and significantly increases the volume of waste water flowing through the waste water treatment plant during heavy rainfall; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Village Council to pass this ordinance as an emergency, in order to have this project completed prior to the onset of winter; and

WHEREAS, on June 7th, 2022, the Village staff publicly opened the only sealed bid received for this project, which was submitted by Underground Utilities, Inc., for \$577,411; and

WHEREAS, Underground Utilities, Inc., has been determined by the Village's civil engineering consultant to be a reputable general contractor, working throughout the northcentral Ohio area on similar projects for many years and the said consultant therefore formally recommends awarding Phase 9, 10 & 11 of this project to Underground Utilities, Incorporated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Fredericktown, Knox County, Ohio, as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** Village Council awards the \$577,411 contract for the Village of Fredericktown's 2022 Sewer Separation Project Phase 9, 10 & 11 to Underground Utilities, Inc.
- **SECTION 2.** On behalf of the Village, a contract for performing work on the said project shall be signed by the Mayor, or his designee, and by the contractor.
- **SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowable by law.
