WHEREAS, the objective of the proposed Streetscape Project is to improve streets and sidewalks in the downtown area and to improve accessibility in a safe and aesthetically pleasing manner.

SECTION 2. Should the owner referenced in Section 1 be unwilling to accept the terms offered, the steps necessary to remove the referenced encroachment shall be taken.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowable by law.
