A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO APPLY FOR COUNTY PERMISSIVE FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Village Council has appropriated funds for the maintenance and repair of streets and alleys within the Village of Fredericktown; and

WHEREAS, Village Council has access to additional County Permissive Funds, which may be applied to the Village's 2022 Street Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvements herein above described are considered to be a priority need for public safety in the community; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Fredericktown, Knox County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Fiscal Officer is authorized by Council to request County Permissive Funds which are available for street replacement and repairs.

SECTION 2. Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, welfare and morals, such emergency arising out of the need to expedite repair of Village infrastructure. This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowable by law.
