RESOLUTION NO. 2022-28

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN VILLAGE PROPERTY SURPLUS AND DISPOSING OF THAT PROPERTY THROUGH INTERNET AUCTION ON GOVDEALS.COM

WHEREAS, in accordance with Chapter 721 of the Ohio Revised Code, and in an effort to get maximum return on surplus property, it has been the practice of the Village Council of Fredericktown, Ohio, to sell its surplus property through Internet auction; and

WHEREAS, the Village acquired its gray 2011 Chevrolet Impala (VIN: 2G1WD5EM8B1136092) brand new, and this vehicle was used for approximately eight years as a police cruiser, and an additional three years as a staff vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Fredericktown has no future need for its 2011 Chevrolet Impala, as this vehicle has sustained eleven years and approximately 115,500 miles of normal wear and tear; and

WHEREAS, the Village acquired a John Deere 2040 tractor (Serial number: 268473) and a bush-hog attachment in, or around, 1978, and this tractor has been used extensively to load salt and also for bush-hogging (mowing weeds); and

WHEREAS, the Village of Fredericktown has no future need for its John Deere 2040 and/or its John Deere bush-hog attachment, as this equipment has sustained forty-four years of normal wear and tear; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village's 2011 Chevrolet Impala and 1978 John Deere 2040 (along with John Deere bush-hog attachment) shall hereby be declared surplus and shall be disposed of via online auction on GovDeals.com by the Village Administrator, according to state law.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowable by law.
