The Fredericktown Village Council met in regular session on April 6, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. at the Fredericktown Municipal Building.

PRESENT: Council Members Brewer, Cline, Lanuzza, McKnight, Pugh and Shoemaker; Administrator Snell; Chief Sheffer; Fiscal Officer Graves.

Mayor Jerry Day called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

MINUTES: Pugh made a motion to approve the March 16, 2026 council meeting minutes. Seconded by Cline. All Yea.

- Frank Harmon, Ohio Insurance Services, gave presentation on new health insurance for employees. Lanuzza made a motion to go with the new Angle (Cigna) insurance, covering 10% of the 20% co-insurance (up to \$1,000) for each employee on the insurance, once deductible is met.
