

**ORDINANCE NO 2021-10**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER  
TO SUBMIT THE PROPOSED 2022 BUDGET  
FOR THE VILLAGE OF FREDERICKTOWN TO  
THE KNOX COUNTY AUDITOR**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Fredericktown is charged with the responsibility of issuing a budget showing the anticipated income and estimated expenses for the Village of each year, and,

**WHEREAS**, Council has reviewed the current and projected income and expenditures for the Village for the purpose of establishing the annual budget; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Village of Fredericktown, Knox County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. That the Fiscal Officer is authorized to submit the attached proposed budget for 2022 to the Knox County Auditor.

Section 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon the affirmative vote of a majority of the members of the Fredericktown Village Council, at the earliest period allowed by law.
