RESOLUTION NO. 2021-14

A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE 2021 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT TO KOKOSING CONSTRUCTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the 2021 Street Improvement Project shall be completed as described in this resolution, contingent on the Village receiving previously requested project funding (through passage of Resolution 2020-26) from the Ohio Public Works Commission: and

WHEREAS, this project consists of milling asphalt and overlaying with virgin asphalt all of W. College Street, all of Mill Street, and an approximately 1,124 linear foot portion of Mount Vernon Avenue, a portion of which is shared with the Knox County Engineer; and

WHEREAS, in addition to paving, this project shall include partnering with the Knox County Engineer in performing structural maintenance and repair work on the Mill Street Bridge; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Fredericktown publicly solicited bids for this project pursuant to dictates of the Ohio Revised Code for the Village's 2021 Street Improvement Project, as the estimated cost of the said project is \$200,000; and

WHEREAS, upon publicly opening the two submitted bids on May 27th, 2021, Kokosing Construction had submitted the lowest bid of \$200,430.40 for the said project; and

WHEREAS, Kokosing Construction has been determined by the Village engineering consultant to be a reputable general contractor performing quality work throughout the region for many years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Fredericktown, Knox County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. Village Council awards the contract for the Village of Fredericktown's 2021 Street Improvement Project to Kokosing Construction in the amount of \$200,430.40.

SECTION 2. In an effort get this project scheduled for 2021, and to reduce risk of causing damage to passing vehicles, this Resolution shall be passed as an emergency, with only one reading, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
