

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-15

A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE EAST FIRST STREET PARKING LOT IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT TO AMBROSE ASPHALT, INC, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the E. First Street Parking Lot Improvements Project shall be completed as described in this resolution: and

WHEREAS, the Village of Fredericktown publicly solicited bids for this project, with the intention of awarding the project to the “best and lowest” bidder; and

WHEREAS, this project consists of milling asphalt and overlaying with virgin asphalt the Village’s public parking located adjacent to the intersection of E. First Street and N. Pleasant Street; and

WHEREAS, the contracted Village engineering consultant, K.E. McCartney, has estimated the cost of the said project to be approximately \$36,000; and

WHEREAS, upon publicly opening the three submitted bids for the E. First Street Parking Lot Improvements Project on May 27th, 2021, Ambrose Asphalt, Inc. had submitted the lowest bid of \$34,096.50; and

WHEREAS, Ambrose Asphalt, Inc. has been determined by the Village engineering consultant to be a reputable paving contractor, performing quality work throughout the region.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Fredericktown, Knox County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. Village Council awards the contract for the Village of Fredericktown’s E. First Street Parking Lot Improvements Project to Ambrose Paving, Inc in the amount of \$34,096.50.

SECTION 2. In an effort to schedule this project as soon as lawfully possible, and to reduce risk of creating further soil erosion between the said parking lot and the Owl Creek Trail, this Resolution shall be passed as an emergency, with only one reading, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
