REGULAR SESSION

The Fredericktown Village council met in regular session on June 7, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. at the Fredericktown Municipal Building.

PRESENT: Council Members Brewer, De Rojas, Lanuzza, McKnight, Shoemaker and Van Nostrand; Fiscal Officer Graves; Village Administrator Snell; Chief Johnson.

Mayor Day called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

MINUTES: Brewer made a motion to approve the May 17, 2021 minutes with the correction of a name change. Seconded by Van Nostrand. All yea.

- Rita Fenton and Nita Chester; Rita has concerns about the intersection at West 5th and Chestnut Streets, it is difficult to pull out onto street because of parked cars so close to intersection. No viable solution at this time - Chief Johnson said they cannot just change one street to no street parking, would have to change all streets.
Asked why the bike trail isn't connected to other villages or towns. Referred to County Commissioners.
Would like to see pest waste stations along Burgett Drive. Referred to the Parks Department.
