

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-24

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED FOR THIS PROJECT AND DECLARING THIS LEGISLATION AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Fredericktown is planning to complete capital improvements to its highway infrastructure in 2022, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority needed for the safety and well-being of the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Fredericktown:

Section 1: The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

Section 2: The Village Administrator is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3. This proposed project shall be referred to by the Village of Fredericktown as the *2022 Street Improvement Project*.

This Resolution shall be passed as emergency, in order to meet OPWC application deadlines.
