

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-15

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN VILLAGE PROPERTY SURPLUS
TO THE NEEDS OF THE VILLAGE OF FREDERICKTOWN,
DISPOSING OF THE PROPERTY THROUGH INTERNET AUCTION, REPLACING THE
PROPERTY AT STATE BID PRICING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Chapter 721 of the Ohio Revised Code, it has been the practice of the Village Council of Fredericktown, Ohio, to sell its surplus property through an Internet auction in order to maximize our return on surplus property; and

WHEREAS, for the 2022 calendar year, the Village of Fredericktown intends to sell its surplus to the best and highest bidder, utilizing the online auction services of GovDeals, located on the Internet at www.GovDeals.com; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Village Council to replace a 2003, half-ton, 2WD Chevrolet work truck, blue in color, with a 2022 Chevrolet, half-ton, 2WD, four-cylinder; and

WHEREAS, this resolution shall be declared an emergency so as to allow the Village to take advantage of the recent availability of a new work truck from Fredericktown Chevrolet, who quoted us the lowest price of \$27,530, which is also below the current “state-bid” price of \$33,645.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following property has been determined to no longer be effectively needed for public service and shall hereby be declared surplus and shall be disposed of via online auction on GovDeals.com by the Village Administrator, according to state law:

- Chevrolet ½ ton, two-wheel-drive, pick-up truck, blue in color; VIN: 1GCEC14V23Z234343

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowable by law.
