A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Fredericktown is planning to make improvements to its highway infrastructure and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority needed for safety of the community and is thereby a qualified project under the OPWC programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Fredericktown:

Section 1: The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

Section 2: The Village Administrator is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3. This proposed project shall be referred to by the Village of Fredericktown as the 2025 Street Improvement Project.

This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
