

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-25

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) FUNDING THROUGH THE TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP)

WHEREAS, ODOT provides funding through the TAP, offering assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Fredericktown has seen a significant increase in vehicular, pedestrian and bicycle traffic since partnering with ODOT on the Safe Routes to School Project, in 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Fredericktown anticipates carrying out the 2028 Sidewalk Improvements, which will increase connectivity by substantially improving ADA compliance from the Fredericktown Local Schools campus to the Public Square; and

WHEREAS, additional improvements may include replacement of inadequate street lighting with decorative street light poles and LED lighting; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvements herein above described is fall within TAP funding requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Fredericktown:

Section 1: The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to apply for TAP funding to the through ODOT, as described above.

Section 2: The Village Administrator is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3. This proposed project shall be referred to by the Village of Fredericktown as the *2028 Sidewalk Improvements*.

This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
