RESOLUTION NO. 2025-27

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) GRANT FUNDING THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT)

WHEREAS, the Village partnered with ODOT on the Safe Routes to School Project in 2017, installing approximately one mile of new ADA compliant sidewalks for pedestrians and bicyclists of all ages along streets going to/from the Fredericktown Local Schools campus; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Fredericktown recently completed their North Main Streetscape Project which included replacing dilapidated sidewalks in downtown Fredericktown; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Fredericktown anticipates partnering with ODOT once again in 2028 on the South Main Streetscape Project; and

WHEREAS, Village Council is committed to continue partnering with ODOT in connecting residential areas with the school campus and the Downtown Business District by improving existing sidewalks and constructing new sidewalks throughout the Village; and

WHEREAS, it is Council's desire to improve the sidewalk on Columbus Road, between Mohican Drive and South Main Street, with ADA compliant sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvements herein above-described fall within Transportation TAP guidelines: and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Fredericktown:

Section 1: The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to apply for additional TAP Funding for the proposed Columbus Road Sidewalk Improvements.

Section 2: On behalf of the Village, the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this TAP Funding.

Section 3. This proposed project shall be referred to by the Village of Fredericktown as the Columbus Road Sidewalk Improvements.
