A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE KNOX COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY'S HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AND PASSING AS AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council hereby recognizes the threat that natural and other potential hazards pose to persons and property within the Fredericktown Community; and

WHEREAS, Knox County Emergency Management Agency (KCEMA) has prepared a multihazard mitigation plan, hereby known as Knox County Hazard Mitigation Plan in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, this comprehensive plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Knox County from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the said plan by Fredericktown Village Council demonstrates our commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Knox County Hazard Mitigation Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by this Council of the Village of Fredericktown that:

- **Section 1**. Council hereby adopts the Knox County Hazard Mitigation Plan as the Village's own plan for mitigating hazards, be it natural hazards or other hazards.
- **Section 2.** Council shall hereby partner with Knox County in mitigating the said hazards, according to the Hazard Mitigation Plan, thus following the leadership of the Knox County Emergency Management Agency.
- **Section 3.** This Resolution shall be passed as an emergency, in order to adopt the said mitigation plan by the end of the 2025 calendar year.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
