

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-02

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ADR INNOVATION FOR THIRD-PARTY REVIEW OF THE ENGINEERING AND DESIGN WORK ON THE SOUTH MAIN STREETSCAPE PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Village has been awarded \$1,000,000 in federal funding to be administered by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) for the Village's South Main Streetscape Project; and

WHEREAS, after requesting qualifications from area civil engineering firms, Council selected K.E. McCartney to perform the engineering and design work on the South Main Streetscape Project; and

WHEREAS, ODOT requires a third-party professional engineer to review the primary engineering and design work for this federally funded project; and

WHEREAS, the Village staff previously requested qualifications from approximately five reputable civil engineering firms in the area for a professional engineer's review of K.E. McCartney's engineering and design work on the South Main Streetscape Project; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and the recommendation of staff to enter into an agreement with ADR Innovations to review K.E. McCartney's engineering and design work on the aforementioned project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Fredericktown:

Section 1. The Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to enter into an agreement with ADR Innovations for engineering & design review on the South Main Streetscape Project.

Section 2. ADR shall invoice the Village at a rate of \$195 per hour and the total cost of the aforementioned review work shall not exceed \$2,925.

This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
