

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-19

AN ORDINANCE AWARDING THE VILLAGE OF FREDERICKTOWN 2026 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FOR MIAMI AVENUE, SALEM AVENUE EXTENSION, BLACKBURN AVENUE AND W. FIRST STREET TO KOKOSING CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC., AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR VILLAGE ADMNISTRATOR TO SIGN AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH KOKOSING CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC., AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Fredericktown has solicited bids, according to law, for the 2026 Street Improvement Project for Miami Avenue, Salem Avenue Extension, Blackburn Avenue and W. First Street for the Village of Fredericktown; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Fredericktown believes that the bid solicited from Kokosing Construction Company, Inc. is the best bid available based on all factors, including price, experience, performance record, financial condition and locality and believes that it is in the public interest to accept such bid on the terms and conditions set forth in the bid received and set forth in the bid documents; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Fredericktown, Knox County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Village Council awards the 2026 Street Improvement Project for Miami Avenue, Salem Avenue Extension, Blackburn Avenue and W. First Street to Kokosing Construction Company, Inc., on the terms and conditions set forth in the bid received and set forth in the bid documents.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor or Village Administrator is hereby authorized to sign a contract for repaving with Kokosing Construction, Inc. pursuant to the bid received and the terms and conditions in the bid documents.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare and shall be effective immediately. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to fully complete the project prior to community events and other projects.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency and shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
