**RESOLUTION OF CONTINGENY FINANCIAL PLAN FOR UTILITIES
EXPENDITURES AND PASSING AS AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Environmental Protection Agency Regulation 3745-85-04 requires certain funds be budgeted for emergency use, along with a statement indicating who can authorize expenditures of said funds in emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Fredericktown, in order to comply with said regulation, hereinafter formally amends Resolution 1982-1 and sets forth the Village staff authorized to give approval of said expenditures.

WHEREAS, in order to promptly comply with EPA requirements, this Resolution shall be passed as an emergency.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Fredericktown, Knox County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. That should an emergency arise concerning providing safe drinking water to the Village of Fredericktown and its service area, the following positions shall be authorized to expend monies budgeted for said emergencies in the following order:

- a) Utility Superintendent; if not available then
- b) Village Administrator; if not available then
- c) Mayor of the Village of Fredericktown; if not available then
- d) President of Council of the Village of Fredericktown

SECTION 2. Such expenditures may only be made if a valid emergency arises and under the authority of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency Regulation 3745-85.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval by Village Council.
